# The McKenzie Family History



The McKenzie Family has been in the Funeral Profession since 1946 with Don McKenzie working at several funeral homes in Vancouver & West Vancouver. Don met & married Jessie in 1948 and in 1968 they were given the opportunity to purchase Hollyburn Funeral Home in West Vancouver from the "Walsh" family. As in true family funeral home tradition, Don & Jessie started George (their eldest son) working at Hollyburn at the age of 14 answering phones and helping his Dad on services. George then went on to B.C.I.T. where he received his Diploma & License as a Funeral Director & Licensed Embalmer and received the "Professionalism Award" for his class year.

In 1988 George & Mildred bought Squamish Funeral Chapel & installed their own Crematorium to service both Hollyburn and the Sea to Sky Corridor. Unfortunately in 1995 after the passing of Don & Jessie, Hollyburn was sold to a corporation in Houston, Texas.

Mildred & George continued to serve families on the North Shore and after several requests from families and clergy, decided to open an office back in West Vancouver, McKenzie Funeral Services. They have brought their own special personalized service back to the North Shore and Lower Mainland. They believe a funeral is similar to other ceremonies in our lives. When you wish to have family and close friends present for the inument of your loved ones cremains at a plot at a cemetery in the Greater Vancouver Area & North Shore. We can help make this service meaningful for your family.

### **Storage of Cremated Remains :**

Under Section (13, Prohibited Charges) of the Cremation, Internment, and Funeral Services Regulation, an operator and a funeral provider must not charge for holding or storing cremated remains during the 60 day period following cremation.

Following the 60 days after the cremation date, McKenzie Funeral Services Ltd. will charge **\$5** a day for storage of cremated remains.


